CIP provides pre-departure orientation and emergency response services for all students going abroad.

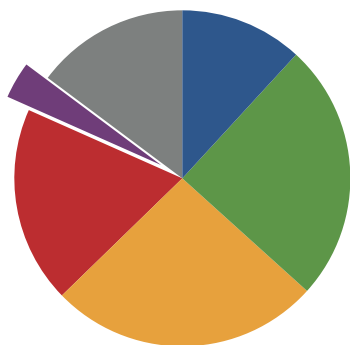
FORMAL STUDY ABROAD (Total 340)

INCOMING EXCHANGE (Total 142)

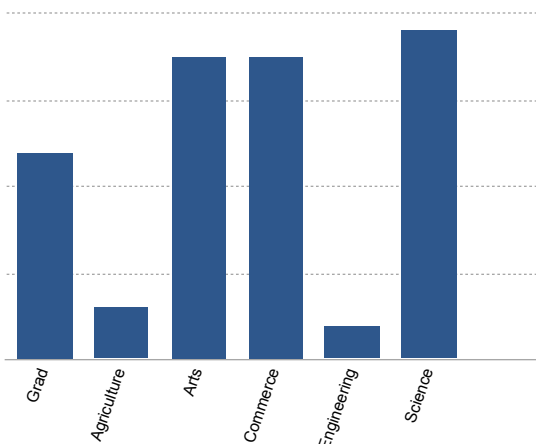

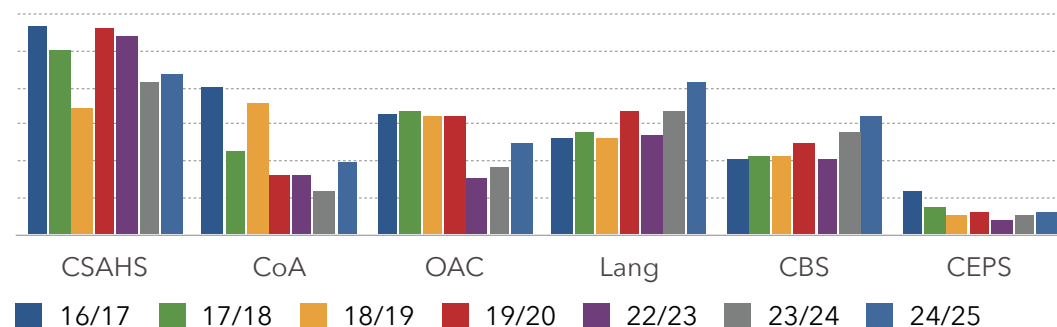
