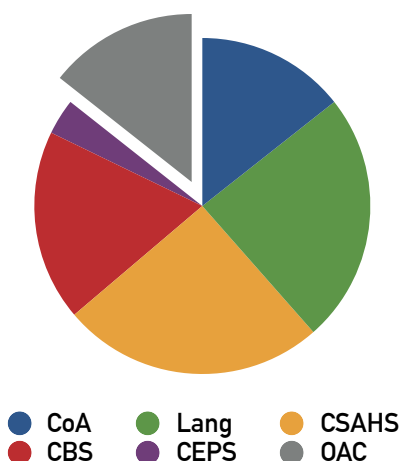
815 TOTAL U of G STUDENT PARTICIPANTS (26.9% increase from 23/24):

340 in formal study abroad programs (exchange, field school, and research internships run by CIP)

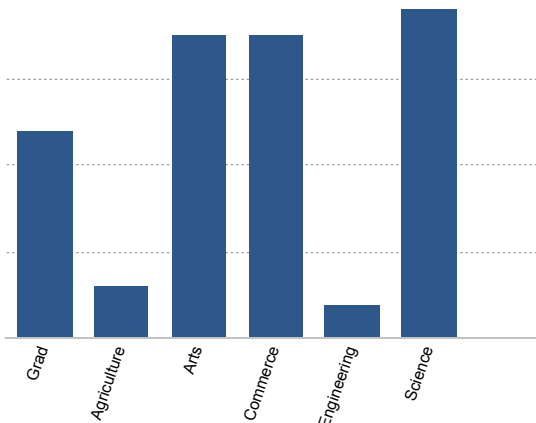
475 in individual study/research, departmental, and co-op programs

### FORMAL STUDY ABROAD (Total 340)



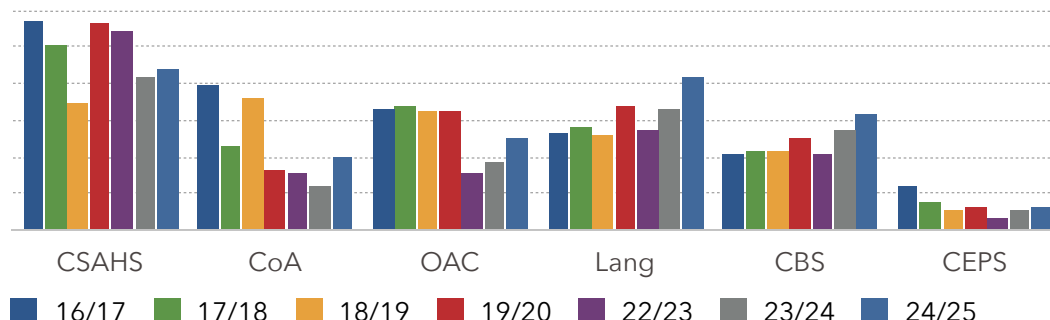
### INCOMING EXCHANGE (Total 142)
